Will there be a twilight book about jacob and renesmee

Now... to the question at hand. The imprint bond is explained by Jacob thusly: "It's not like love at first sight, really. It's not the earth holding you here anymore, she does... You become whatever she needs you to be, whether that's a protector, or a lover, or a friend." This doesn't necessarily require romantic connection even though the rest of the text absolutely alludes to that inevitability. Jacob is just going to date. "But he's not a vampire, he's going to die!" You say. Well. The Quileutes are effectively immortal. When they phase into a wolf for the first time, they stop aging. There are plenty-a-plot-holes here BUT if Jacob maintains a regularly scheduled shape shift, he can essentially stay young forever. This is a good thing because Renesmee will be Jacob's age physically in a mere few years. Jacob being frozen in time at least let's Renesmee catch up, and when it becomes romantic in a few decades (hopefully) they'll both be emotionally mature and physically young together forever. Jacob imprinting on Renesmee may be the most problematic choice Meyer made in the entire series because it has so many bad implications, like grooming and taking away agency. It is also, I imagine, one of the trickier things to translate into a visual medium. When asked how he found the line between Jacob being caring and creepy, Taylor Lautner said in a 2012 press conference for Breaking Dawn, Part 2 (via Collider): "Yeah, it's a fine line and I was worried about it. We were very lucky to have Stephenie Meyer, the author, on set with us for these last two movies, and I definitely had quite a few conversations with her. There was nobody better to ask about it than her, and she basically told me, 'Stop over-complicating it. Think here and now. That's lifelong bond between two people, and that's it. At this point, it's more of a brother-sister protective thing. That's really all it is. I couldn't allow myself to think ahead and go beyond that, so that's the zone I had to stay in. Bill [Condon], our director, did a tremendous job with it because it is delicate. I think the fans are going to be happy with it."Lautner did the best with what he was given, but the source material left very little room to improve upon this... awkward relationship dynamic. At least there are in-universe rules that allow for a more appropriate relationship to form between Jacob and Renesmee over the course of many, many years. Whatever happens with Nessie and Jake in the future, shippers can sleep well knowing that Renesmee will never be alone, as long as she wants to keep Jacob around. In honor of such, Stephanie Meyers hung out with some fans at a special viewing of Twilight in an LA theater and after she answered some questions. This event was co-hosted by one of my favorite YouTube book reviewers, Christine Riccio from polandbananasBOOKS. Christine Riccio recorded a vlog about this and it's where we found out that Stephanie Meyer has the whole story mapped out and it's probably a 2 or 3 book story arc. While I was procrastinating some real editing work (I'm always at my most creative when procrastinating), I started to wonder how the first chapter of Twilight would read if it were written from Edward's perspective. There is so much more to his side of the story than there is to Bella's in that first chapter. After all, Bella only knows that an incredibly gorgeous boy is looking at her funny. Meanwhile, Edward is suffering through one of the most momentous days of his very long life! First there's the shock and frustration of not being able to hear Bella's thoughts, then the wild, monstrous reaction to her scent, followed by the incredible expenditure of self-control that it takes to not kill her... His side of Bella's first day at Forks High School is a hundred times more exciting than her own." In 2009 she even released. Will it be released? It doesn't sound like it. it seems like she doesn't feel like there would be enough interest in the story after such a long period of time. However, the good news is, there is still hope for the Jacob and Renesmee story. August 2020 Update: Stephenie Meyer finally released "Midnight Sun", that's a retelling of the original story, only from Edward's Point of View instead of Bella's. It's more of a companion novel, then a new book in the series, but for die-hard Twilight fans, this will be something you will want to check out. It gives us a detailed look at how Edward sees things as well as those around him, including Alice, and a more detailed look at how be chose Edward, and together they had a child, who they named Renesmee — a half-human, half-vampire hybrid. This however is not the promised Stephanie Meyer coming out. On the 10 year anniversary of the Twilight saga, she did a Q&A during which time she said she had plotted out the Jacob and Renesmee story. It will be two, possibly three books. This was said in October of 2018. She has to start working on that again. Two years later we did get the completed and updated release of Midnight Sun, which was met with huge critical praise. That hopefully will encourage her to actually put pen to paper and finish the Jacob and Renesmee book, picking up after Jacob Imprinted on Renesmee and then into their adult lives together. Stephenie Meyer has teased more books as part of the Twilight series, and here's what we know about them so far. In August 2020, while promoting Midnight Sun, Meyer revealed she has two more Twilight books planned, but she didn't share any details at the time, though she did say that she already has them outlined. Breaking Dawn brought the arcs of Bella, Edward, and Jacob to an end, though it's up to every reader and viewer to decide if they were satisfying endings. Meyer is known for taking her time to write, and if there are obstacles like leaks and more (as happened with Midnight Sun), the release date can take a lot longer than fans would like. Twilight: Breaking Dawn Sequel Book Story Details On her official website, Stephenie Meyer explained that, when she gets back to Twilight, the story "will revolve around the same characters" but now with Renesmee and Leah Clearwater as narrators, thus exploring the vampire and werewolf sides of the story. Meyer also added it will be set "five or ten or fifteen years after the end of Breaking Dawn", though that depends on when she finally gets to write the book, so the time setting, just like the characters, can change once she starts writing.
